


Google News Alerts: News alerts delivered directly to your email inbox from Google News


Special Note to Gmail Users

Google News Alerts and Gmail work together which means if you are logged into your Gmail account, alerts will automatically go to your Gmail account without asking for an alternate email address.

1) **Logout of your Gmail account if you want your alerts to come to a non-Gmail address.** In your web browser, type in **news.google.com** and press “Enter” on your keyboard.



2) When the “Google News” web site appears, move your mouse over the arrow beside the blue & white search magnifying glass. The words “Advanced news search” will appear.







3) After clicking on the “Advanced news search” arrow, a box will appear with a list of choices to help create your news alert. Here are a few tips for setting up your search:

- * **all these words** – returns results with typed in words located anywhere in the article
- * **this exact phrase** – returns only results with the exact phrase in the article
- * **at least one of the words** – returns results with any of the typed words in the article
- * **none of these words** – returns articles which will not include the typed words in the article
- * **Source** – Specify a particular publication
- * **Location** – Specify articles that occur in a specified country, state or city

Example: In the example to right the search is for the exact phrase “general assembly” pertaining to the state of “NC” as the location.

You may use any combination of boxes to make your search more exact.



<p>Click  when you are ready to run your search. Note: The date fields do not affect Google News Alerts.</p>	
<p>4) After clicking  a page will appear with the list of your results. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click  to setup your news alerts.</p>	
<p>5) After clicking  a page will appear that will show you the alert you are creating. Type in the email address where you want to receive your alerts and click .</p>	
<p>Note: Before clicking  there are some options you may choose from to specify how often you receive alerts and from what sources. This may be done by clicking on  beside the “Create Alert” box</p>	
<p>Note continued: After clicking on “Show options,” you may specify</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) how often you want to receive alerts; (2) what types of news sources to receive alerts from (3) the region of the world you want to search and (4) how many results you want to receive. <p>Remember that this step is optional.</p>	

<p>6) After clicking CREATE ALERT a short message will appear at the top of your screen confirming that a news alert request has been sent to your email.</p>	
<p>7) You should get a Google Alerts verification email. Open this email.</p>	
<p>8) Click on the “Verify this Google Alert request:” link and now you will start to receive news alerts from Google News based on the criteria you provided.</p>	
<p>9) Keep this email because you can use it later to stop the Google Alert by clicking on “Cancel this Google Alert request:”</p>
